You are entitled to strike pay if you have joined PAM no later than the first day of a strike at your workplace.

PAM PAYS strike pay 60 €/day to those PAM members who would have had a work shift of at least 4 hours during the strike and therefore lost income. After withholding tax, the strike pay is 44,60€/day.

YOU DON'T NEED TO REGISTER BEFOREHAND.

You can apply for strike pay beginning on the Friday of the week of the strike.

Don't do work tasks that are covered by the strike!

The right to strike is a fundamental right, and therefore employer cannot oblige anyone to do work that is covered by a strike. Every employee has the right to decline to do work covered by the strike.
